

# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Trip to: Six Flags



**DATE:** Wednesday, June 1, 2016

**DEPARTURE TIME:** Students must report to the grass quad area by 10:00am. We are leaving Sierra Vista at 10:30am.

**RETURN TIME:** Parents must be at Sierra Vista by 8:30pm to pick up students, **AND PLEASE DO NOT PARK ALONG THE CURB DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL;** we need this area to park the buses.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Students will be placed on buses by alphabetic order. Students are required to ride the buses to and from Magic Mountain. Parents may **NOT** pick up their student from Magic Mountain, **No Exceptions.** The buses will be leaving Magic Mountain at 8:15pm SHARP. Students must report to the same bus they came on 30 minutes prior, at 7:45 p.m.

**TICKET SALES:** April 11<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> in the ASB office. The cost is \$50.00 per student (with no Season Pass) or \$20 per student with a valid Magic Mountain Season Pass at the time of purchase. Checks should be made payable to: **Sierra Vista Jr. High ASB and please add student ID # on the memo line.** Students must have the attached permission slip signed on both sides and completed at the time of purchase - **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Ticket includes admission to Magic Mountain, Commemorative Shirt and Transportation.

**REFUND POLICY:** Students who are unable to attend will be eligible for a \$30.00 refund until May 25<sup>th</sup>, but there will not be a refund for season pass holders. All are subject to administrator's approval. Sorry, we are unable to refund the cost of transportation.

**Note:** If a student is pulled from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip due to academics, behavior (including demerits), or illness after May 1<sup>st</sup>, they will not be eligible for the transportation refund as we will have ordered buses based on the number of students as of that date.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Students who attend this trip are representatives of our school and community. Students will be expected to abide by Magic Mountain's dress code, which includes no attire that in anyway promotes or advertises alcohol, drugs, or gangs. Students wearing such items or other attire deemed inappropriate for school will not be allowed to board the bus leaving Sierra Vista. Sierra Vista's dress code policy will be enforced.

Additionally, any student taken into custody by Magic Mountain security for any reason, will have their parent/guardian contacted to pick them up from Magic Mountain. Students that are disciplinary problems on the bus or at Magic Mountain risk being denied the ability to participate in the 8th Grade BBQ Celebration on June 2<sup>nd</sup> as well as possible suspensions the following week pending our investigation.

**DONATIONS:** We have had some inquiries about helping students that have earned the trip but may struggle to pay the entire cost, in these times of economic hardship. If you wish to help a fellow Sierra Vista family send their student on this trip, please consider donating \$5, \$10, or any other amount. If you choose to donate, please indicate the amount on the back side of your child's permission slip in the indicated section and include the amount with your own payment. Your child's receipt will note the donation, so remind them to keep the receipt for tax purposes. We thank you for your consideration!
